The Gen H internship is a **paid, two-week placement** designed to **support individuals without formal higher education** as they explore opportunities in the technology industry and gain insight into life within a global consultancy.

The programme is built around four key elements.



Selection Process



Step 1 – Application

Applications will be accepted via our online recruitment portal and will include a series of questions, followed by a supporting statement.

Questions

The questions will help us get to know you better – why you're interested in this internship, what motivates you, and how you align with Hitachi Solutions.



Supporting Statement

This is your chance to share anything that supports your application: the skills and traits you possess, experiences you've had, perspectives you hold, and values you live by. Use this space to freely represent yourself in your own way!

Remember, we're not looking for perfection; if you match some of the criteria in our <u>"ideal candidate persona"</u>, we encourage you to apply!



Essential criteria:

- ⊘ Have the right to work in the UK
- ⊘ Be over the age of 18
- Minimum required level of education - secondary school
- Proficient in English (both verbal and written).
- Basic knowledge of Microsoft suite with tools such as Word, Excel, Outlook etc
- Must be able to attend the complete internship programme
- Must be able to attend our assessment centre, in our Head office in London (110 Bishopsgate)
- Must be able to spend 3 days per week in our Head Office in London (110 Bishopsgate)

Step 2 – Telephone Interview

You'll be notified at least one week before your telephone interview, giving you plenty of time to prepare and feel confident. To support you every step of the way, we've gathered a few practical tips and tricks to help you excel.



Articulation is extra important on the phone as listeners lack visual cues like body language and facial expressions to interpret messages.



Keep any notes in front of you for easy reference and take any notes you need throughout the interview.



Make sure to listen carefully and try not to interrupt. However we urge you to ask questions when needed to fully understand the interviewer's question.



Choose a quiet location where you won't be interrupted. Consider informing others around you and if possible, close doors and windows to reduce background noise.



Despite all your best intentions, things can still go wrong. Stay calm, think of solutions, and ask for help if needed.

Step 3 – Assessment Centre

Our assessment centre is a comprehensive evaluation process designed to measure the various skills, traits and competencies displayed by candidates throughout the day.

We have incorporated a mix of individual and group sessions to ensure each candidate has the opportunity to showcase their strengths in a way that best suits their individual preferences and styles.

The sessions include:

- ⊘ An online assessment
- ⊘ A writing task
- \bigcirc An interview
- ⊘ A meet with our SLT
- ⊘ A group exercise

If you are asked to attend the Assessment Centre then we will provide detailed information, support and guidance on each section to help you prepare as best as possible.

For the candidates who are asked to attend the assessment Centre but are unsuccessful, we would be delighted to offer you the opportunity to have a mentoring session with one of our D&A consultants. They will be able to offer you advice about the industry, what it's like working in data and analytics as well as provide any support as to recommended next steps.
